B – Governance Process

Governance and Accountability

Background

The Ministry of Colleges and Universities, through its Colleges of Applied Arts and Technology Policy Framework, specifically identifies a framework for Governance and Accountability. This framework clearly states:

Governance may be defined as the legislation, policies and procedures under which an organization is governed and the decision-making structures it employs. The authority to establish colleges of applied arts and technology is set out in the Ontario Colleges of Applied Arts and Technology Act, 2002. The Act identifies each college as a corporation without share capital and consisting of the members of its board of governors. The board of governors governs each college on behalf of the public. The Ontario Not-for-profit Corporations Act, 2010, governs the operation of the college except where limited by the Ontario Colleges of Applied Arts and Technology Act, 2002, and its regulations.

The objects of the colleges as set out in subsections 2 (2) and (3) of the Act: "To offer a comprehensive program
